

UNLV Research Study

We at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas STAR Clinic are studying mental health outcomes among adolescents receiving care from the Southern Nevada Children's Advocacy Center (SNCAC). The purpose of this study is to improve treatments for adolescents who are recovering from stressful events.

Participation in this study is voluntary and does not impact the ability to receive care from SNCAC.

You may be eligible if you are...

- A girl aged 13-17
- Receiving services at SNCAC
- And have access to a device with internet access

What will this study involve?

- Initial survey (45 minutes, compensated \$40)
- Brief phone surveys for two weeks (2 minutes, 3/day, \$1 per brief survey)
- 1 week survey (1 hour, compensated \$50)
- 6 week survey (1 hour, compensated \$50)
- 3 month survey (1 hour, compensated \$50)

All study activities are compensated via gift card.
